

Corallo Temporary Exhibition

This exciting educational resource is now available for lending by schools across Malta.

A dynamic and interactive learning experience

This innovative exhibition provides a captivating exploration of the Maltese coastline, encompassing its geology, rich biodiversity, cultural significance, and the importance of environmental protection. Comprising four self-contained units that can be arranged flexibly, the exhibition requires a modest space of approximately 10 x 5 meters.

Easy setup and operation

The exhibition is designed for ease of installation and operation. A simple power supply for five plugs is all that is required, and the audiovisual elements operate on a continuous loop. Once set up, the exhibition can be left unattended, requiring only a brief morning start-up and evening shutdown.

Please note: If the exhibition is not being mounted on ground-floor level, the school must provide assistance to Heritage Malta staff to facilitate the setup of the exhibition.

Engaging content for students

The exhibition caters to students in both middle and secondary schools, offering a comprehensive and informative overview of the Maltese coastline. Interactive elements and engaging multimedia content ensure an engaging and memorable learning experience.

Promoting environmental awareness

The exhibition seamlessly integrates environmental studies with an empowering message about the importance of protecting our coastline for future generations. It highlights the delicate balance of nature and the actions we can take to safeguard this precious resource.

Ideal for two- to three-week instalments

The exhibition's compact size and self-sufficient operation make it ideal for hosting in schools for two to three weeks at a time. This allows students to immerse themselves in the content and gain a deeper understanding of the Maltese coastline's significance.
